

POY Ambassador Guidelines

Project of the Year (POY) Ambassadors are PMI Manitoba volunteers that excel in educating and influencing Project Managers and Project Sponsors in their organizations in order to submit their projects for Project of the Year.

Requirements

The POY Ambassadors can volunteer within their organizations or circles of influence by performing any, some or all of the following activities:

- Educate their Project Management or Business Executive peers about POY. This includes:
 - The benefits of nominating their project
 - The submission process
 - The awards and recognition
- Identify projects within their organization that are eligible and create a network of potential nominees.
- Liaise with other Project Managers or Sponsors to influence their decision to submit their project for POY.
- Assist with the submission of one or more projects for POY. This may include:
 - Facilitating meetings and decisions
 - Assist with the write up and reviews
 - Consolidating the supporting materials (photos, etc.)
 - Obtaining approvals

The POY Ambassadors are required to document and provide tangible progress on their activities to the Chair of the POY Committee.

Eligibility and Benefits

Both member and non-members of PMI Manitoba are eligible. Their organization or circle of influence should be in Manitoba or eligible to submit under the POY Guidelines.

Professional Development Units (PDUs) will be provided for the effort spent on the above tasks. These PDUs qualify under the *“Giving Back to the Profession”* category as specified by PMI Global.

The PDUs will be granted annually on the basis of:

- Maximum of **15 PDUs**, if no submissions resulted from these efforts.
- Maximum of **25 PDUs**, if at least one submission resulted from these efforts.
